Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Conducting Weddings, Funerals and Christenings in keeping with the regulations in place at the time and where circumstances allow organised social events for the church and wider communities. Carried out Doorstep visits for the Housebound and Needy both within the Church and Wider Communities. Provided Chaplaincy service to local Primary and Secondary Schools as requested. Running Kids Clubs. Youth Club, Sports and Social Activities, Participating in Local Authority Warm Hands Project, Community Lego Club and Yoga Classes.

Supporting various NHS appeals such as knitted hats for new born babies through to providing seasonal gifts for Hospitals Discharging Patients to items for those currently in Hospice Care both locally and for Missions Abroad it included all age clothing and basic First Aid and Hygiene Items, along with providing specific knitted items for a baby unit in Malawi. Outwith this also when requested providing specific items for the local drug and alcohol rehabilitation units, food banks and animal charities. We have also been supporting Homeless and Refugee Charities within Central Scotland including the Ukrainian Refugees in West Central Scotland and also in Poland via the Churches missions outreach work.

Through these activities and ventures we have developed a strong relationship with families and organisations both in the local community and further afield and which we plan to continue to support and grow where appropriate.

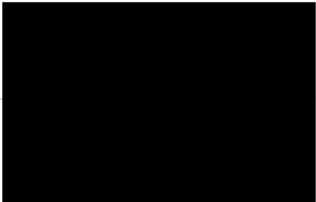
