Children's meetings held on a weekly basis during term time time and over period October to April.

Soup n Sweet on a monthly basis for the over 60's.

Bible Exhibition was held for one week during the month of May for primary school children in the area.

Christmas packs have been delivered to a local charity who help the underprivileged of the area.

2000 calendars delivered to the homes of Inverurie with local interest images and Bible verses.

We had a stand at Oldmeldrum Sports and Turriff show over the summer with the intent of giving Bibles, Christian literature etc to those interested.

We had a stand at the Thainstone Christmas Show where we sold Christmas cards, decorations etc (the proceeds going to a local charity) as well as distributing Bibles and Christian literature to those interested.

Financial aid sent to a variety of people at home and abroad with a view to being a help for folks with spiritual and material needs.
