To do this we partner with communities, churches, organisations, local and national government, to offer tailored support and services. We're ending homelessness in Scotland with 3 streams of support designed to meet people's needs and bring long lasting change. Our integrated approach means we are there for people at every stage as we seek to prevent homelessness, intervene in crisis and sustain people in their own homes. Our services provide high quality, personalised support, giving relief in times of crisis and enabling people to flourish. We support around 7,000 people a year with over 30 different services across Scotland
