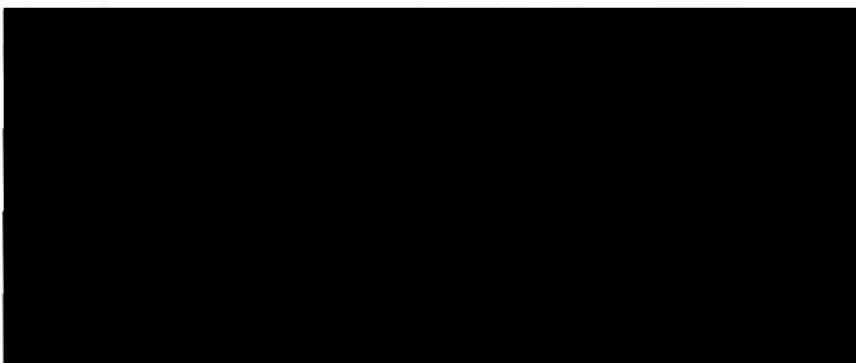

Structure, Governance and Management

The Trust is incorporated under the rules incorporated in the Trust Deed dated 7th February 1985. The Trustees changed the name of the trust from The John & Margaret Fraser Memorial Trust to the Fraser Memorial Trust during the year ended 5 April 2012.

Under the terms of the Trust Deed, the existing Trustees have the power to appoint new and additional Trustees.

The Trustees have assessed the risks to which the charity is exposed, in particular those related to the financial and investment operation of the Trust, and are satisfied that systems are in place to minimise exposure to these risks.

Objectives, Activities and Achievements

Our purpose, as recorded in the trust deed, is to support any charitable, cultural, educational, religious or welfare organisation or organisations for the relief of poverty which have their domicile or carry on their work in Scotland or elsewhere, or more generally for the relief of poverty in Scotland or elsewhere.

In the year under review the Trust had total receipts of £22,189 (2024: £21,964) and made donations to 6 recipients totalling £21,800 (2024: 6 recipients totalling £17,300). Details of the donations are shown in the Notes to the accounts.

Financial Review, Investment Policy and Reserves

The reserves mainly consist of the investments originally settled. These investments are essential to produce the income for distribution.

1. Accounting policies

a) **Basis of preparation**

The Accounts have been prepared on the "receipts and payments" basis and comply with the requirements of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

b) **Investments**

Investments are stated at market value.

c) **Income and Expenditure**

Gifts of investments and cash made to the Trust are accounted for when received. Investment income is accounted for when received, as is bank interest.

Donations and other expenditure are accounted for when paid.

d) **Taxation**

The Trust is recognised by H M Revenue & Customs as a charity for the purposes of the Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1988 and is entitled under Section 13 (2) of the Charities and Trustees Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 to describe itself as a Scottish Charity.

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF THE FRASER MEMORIAL TRUST

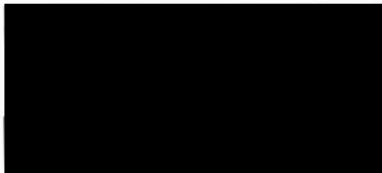
Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement
