We also provided ice lollies for all pupils on sports day, renewed the movie licence allowing programmes and movies to be screened in class time, and continued to fund the annual first aid training of the upper stages pupils.

A number of items from the school's wish list were purchased including a number of resources for the additional support for learning team, a grammar resource, white Rose subscription, and an IT refresh including individual chromebooks for every P7 pupil.

We provided each class with a 'class budget' to allow the class teachers to purchase necessary materials to support their pupils' learning throughout the year.


