## Independent examiner's report on the accounts

On the accounts of the charity for the period 1st January 2025 to 31st December 2025

### *Respective responsibilities of the trustees and examiner*

### *Basis of independent examiner's statement*

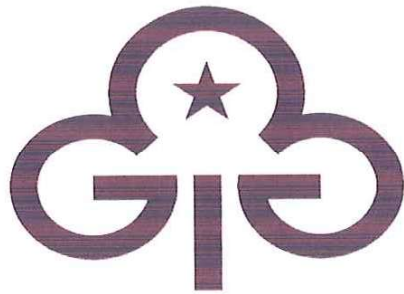

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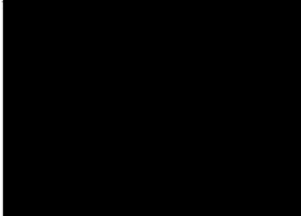

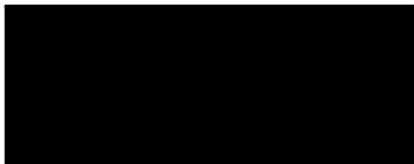
