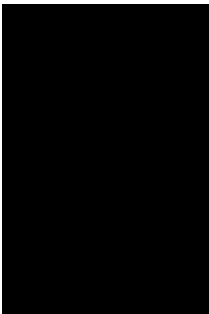

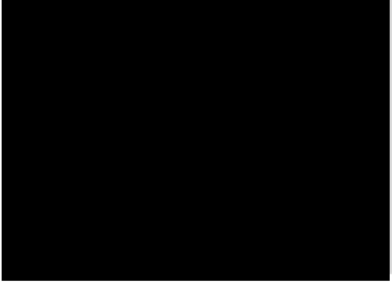
COMMITTEE MEMBERS' REPORT FOR YEAR ENDED 31st JULY 2024

The Members of the Committee present their report and accounts for the year to 31 July 2024

These accounts have been prepared on the Receipts & Payments basis in accordance with the Charities & Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended).

The charity was established by a Charitable Constitution on 30th October 2002.

The Members of the Committee who served during the year were:-



Membership of the Committee will be open to staff employed in the school and to parents of pupils attending the school; membership will reflect the advice of South Ayrshire Council. Membership of the Committee will be reviewed routinely at bi-annual whole-staff meetings and at Parent Council Meetings closest in time to that Staff Meeting. Interim membership alterations shall be decided as appropriate by the Committee and intimated as soon as possible to all staff members and to the Parent Council.

The Committee will meet termly for the conduct of general business and to receive and commission reports. Any member of the Committee may request a Special Meeting.

All questions shall be decided by a majority of those present at the meetings and entitled to vote. The Chairperson will have any casting vote. A quorum is four members of the Committee. There are no related parties.

The members of the Committee have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to the major risks.

Objectives and Activities

The Charity's objectives are to benefit the pupils of Queen Margaret Academy and to promote the generation of monies for the school fund and administer the fund within the guidelines of South Ayrshire Council. There has been no change in these during the year.

The main activities of the school fund involves trips, outings, events and activities which are organised for the benefit of the pupils of Queen Margaret Academy. Funds are raised through these activities to support the school funds and other charitable organisations.

Independent Examiner's Report for the Year Ended 31st July 2024

Independent Examiner's Report to the Committee of Queen Margaret Academy School Fund

I report on the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31st July 2024, which are set out in the following pages.

Respective responsibilities of Members' of the Committee and Examiner

The charity's Members' of the Committee are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 ("the 2005 Act") and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended) ("the 2006 Regulations"). The charity's Members' of the Committee consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)(d) of the 2006 Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section (44)(1)(c) of the 2005 Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the 2006 Regulations. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and, consequently, I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent Examiner's Statement
