Memorials may include important headstones. d) To support the beneficiaries through the promotion of their health, education, sport or cultural opportunities. e) To apply funds for the improvement, efficiency, benefit or welfare of The Black Watch, 3rd Battalion, The Royal Regiment of Scotland or its successor Battalions. f) The promotion by all

charitable means of the qualities of courage, discipline, endurance, integrity, loyalty, respect for others, selfless commitment and a team spirit to improve the condition of young people in particular and society in general. g) To encourage the advancement of heritage and culture by informing the general public about the history and activities of The Black Watch and of the British armed services in general
