(iii) encouraging and enabling provision to help and educate young people through their leisure time activities to provide for spiritual, mental and physical capacities to enable them to grow to full maturity as responsible individuals and members of society so that their conditions of life may be improved. (iv) fostering a community spirit for the achievement of these and such other purposes as may by law be deemed to be charitable.
