Activities: 'It makes grants, donations, loans, gifts or pensions to individuals','It makes grants, donations or gifts to organisations','It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the prevention or relief of poverty','the advancement of education','the advancement of health','the saving of lives','the advancement of citizenship or community development','the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science','the advancement of public participation in sport','the provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended','the advancement of human rights, conflict resolution or reconciliation','the promotion of religious or racial harmony','the promotion of equality and diversity','the advancement of environmental protection or improvement','the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage','any other purpose that may reasonably be regarded as analogous to any of the preceding purposes'

What the charity does: The overriding principle of the charity's existence is to raise funds from its various fundraising activities which should be donated to projects/organisations which work to provide benefits in the broad areas which Rotary strives to support. This applies to donations given for local, national and international purposes. Rotary Foundation, which is Rotary's own charity, has identified seven areas of focus which are, Peace Building and Conflict Resolution, Disease Prevention and Treatment, Water Sanitation and Hygiene, Maternal and Childcare, Basic Education and Literacy, Community Economic Development and Protecting our Environment.

Beneficiaries: 'Children or young people','Older People','People with disabilities or health problems','No specific group, or for the benefit of the community','Other charities or voluntary bodies'

Objectives: The object of the Benevolent Fund shall be to apply the income thereof for the benefit of the poor and needy living within the territorial area of the Club as defined and delineated on the plan thereof at Rotary Headquarters in London or to or for the benefit of such charitable institutions, societies and objects as the Club shall in duly constituted meeting from time to time direct.
