**Activities:** 'It makes grants, donations, loans, gifts or pensions to individuals', 'It makes grants, donations or gifts to organisations'

**Purposes:** 'the advancement of education', 'the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science', 'the advancement of public participation in sport'

**What the charity does:** The Trust aims to assist young Scots and Scottish Institutions. The Trust helps talented and worthy individuals who need help to achieve their objectives by awarding grants. The Director selects those applications that best meet the criteria requirements and these are then considered by the Trustees at their meetings. Grant recipients are required to submit a report to the Trustees on the outcome of their work/studies. While the Trust does not provide multi year awards, the Trustees will consider further support for recipients which is subject to the receipt of a satisfactory report from the previous year. Grants are targeted at individuals of Scots birth, upbringing or formation who are undertaking courses of postgraduate study at educational institutions either at home or abroad.

**Beneficiaries:** 'Children or young people'

**Objectives:** The primary and principal objects of the Trust are the advancement of education for the public benefit, and the provision of facilities for recreation and other leisure-time occupations, such facilities being provided in the interests of social welfare and to assist, support or maintain, financially or otherwise, or to establish bodies corporate or incorporate or trusts, the objects of which are exclusively charitable, and to apply the property and income of the Trust for the purposes which the Law regards as charitable and in such a manner that any other objects powers and provisions referred to in this Constitution shall be deemed to be governed by the primary and principal objects above referred to, and that notwithstanding anything to the

contrary hereinafter expressed or implied.
