FARR HIGH SCHOOL FUND CONSTITUTION

1. The body shall be known as the Farr High School Fund.
2. The aims of the body shall be to further the education of pupils at Farr High School.
3. The governing body shall consist of the following minimum members:
 - Chairman
 - Secretary
 - Treasurer
4. The body shall hold an Annual General Meeting on or about the 5 April each year. The date and time of this meeting to be advertised locally at least two months in advance of the event.
5. The period of service for office bearers shall be three years at the end of which they must stand down and an election of office bearers take place.
6. The treasurer shall keep a proper account of all funds received, held or dispensed by the Fund and this account shall be subject to an annual independent audit prior at the AGM at which it shall be presented in full.
7. The body shall meet at least six times annually, in Farr High School office.
8. The body shall maintain the charitable status gained from the Inland Revenue in 1989 in order that it may continue to obtain financial assistance for charitable objects from funds such as Awards for All.

9. Dissolution

If, upon winding up or dissolution of the Club there remains after the satisfaction of all the Club's debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall be given or transferred to some other organisations having objects (that is, aims and activities) similar to the objects of the Club, such organisation or organisations to be determined by the members of the Club by Resolution passed at a General meeting at or before the time of the dissolution, and in so far as effect cannot be given to such provision then to some charitable objects.

10. The current office bearers of the governing body are:

Chairman - Mrs Katherine Wood re-elected

Secretary - Mrs Amanda Moseley re-elected

Treasurer - Mrs Susan Mackay re-elected

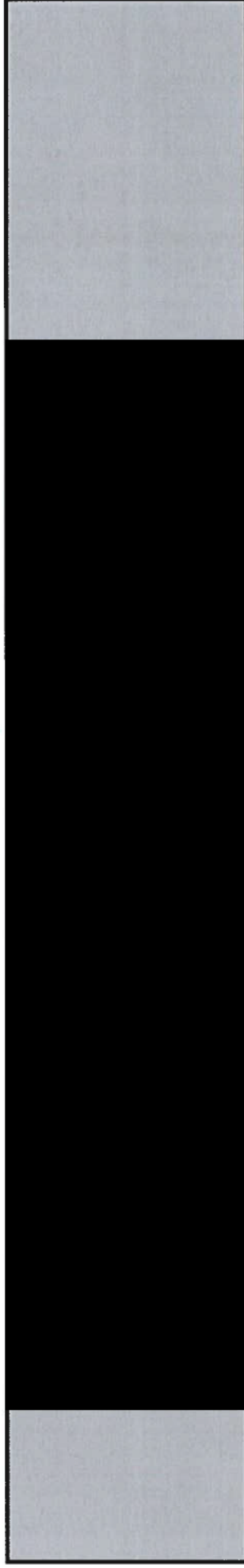

4. The body shall hold an Annual General Meeting on or about the 5 April each year. The date and time of this meeting to be advertised locally at least two months in advance of the event.
5. The period of service for office bearers shall be three years at the end of which they must stand down and an election of office bearers take place.
6. The treasurer shall keep a proper account of all funds received, held or dispensed by the Fund and this account shall be subject to an annual independent audit prior at the AGM at which it shall be presented in full.
7. The body shall meet at least six times annually, in Farr High School office.
8. The body shall maintain the charitable status gained from the Inland Revenue in 1989 in order that it may continue to obtain financial assistance for charitable objects from funds such as Awards for All.

9. Dissolution

If, upon winding up or dissolution of the Club there remains after the satisfaction of all the Club's debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall be given or transferred to some other organisations having objects (that is, aims and activities) similar to the objects of the Club, such organisation or organisations to be determined by the members of the Club by Resolution passed at a General meeting at or before the time of the dissolution, and in so far as effect cannot be given to such provision then to some charitable objects.
