Activities: 'It makes grants, donations or gifts to organisations'

Purposes: 'the prevention or relief of poverty', 'the advancement of education', 'the advancement of religion', 'the advancement of health', 'the saving of lives', 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science', 'the advancement of public participation in sport', 'the provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended', 'the advancement of human rights, conflict resolution or reconciliation', 'the promotion of religious or racial harmony', 'the promotion of equality and diversity', 'the advancement of environmental protection or improvement', 'the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage', 'the advancement of animal welfare', 'any other purpose that may reasonably be regarded as analogous to any of the preceding purposes'

What the charity does: Corra Foundation exists to make a difference to the lives of people and communities. It works with others to encourage positive change, opportunity, fairness and growth of aspirations which improve quality of life. Corra wants to see a society in which people create positive change and enjoy fulfilling lives. In 2020 Corra launched a ten-year strategy. It is long term because making a difference on the big challenges will take time. At its heart is the strong belief that when people find their voice, they unlock the power to make change happen. Corra delivers its strategy in many ways. It gives grants to charities and grassroots groups that make a day-to-day difference to lots of people's lives. Some of that is through funding managed for others, like the Scottish Government. Corra also works alongside communities where people are coming together to find their own solutions to things like loneliness, poverty and health issues.

Objectives: The objects of Corra Foundation are to hold the charitable assets and any income and to pay and apply the same to or for the benefit of or in furtherance of anything which is a charitable purpose or a charitable institution (as defined below) in such proportions and manner as the Trustees shall think fit, principally in but not limited to Scotland, with the particular goal of advancing positive change and promoting opportunities, altruism, fairness and growth of aspirations, to ultimately improve the quality of life for the general public and their communities through the provision of financial and other support, and working in partnerships with others.
