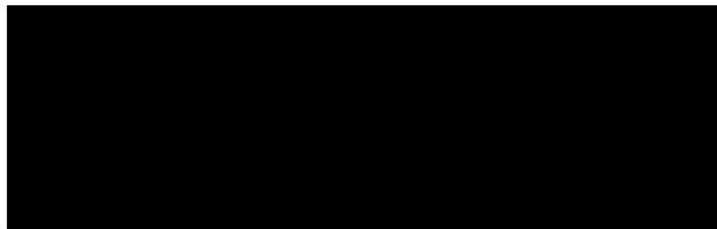

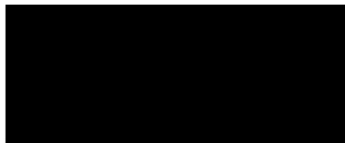

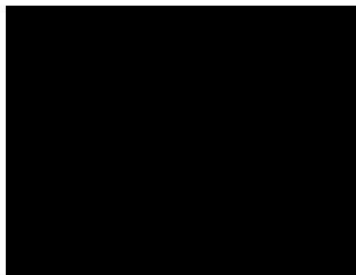

Structure, Governance and Management

The Churches are administered in accordance with the terms of The Deed of Constitution.

Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

Pentland Parish Church of Scotland operates under a unitary constitution. There are five elders. Meetings are held every three months.

Organisational Structure

Our fulltime minister is the Rev. Janet Easton-Berry assisted by the Parish Assistant.

Objectives and Activities

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine, reformed in tradition and Presbyterian in polity. It exists to glorify God and work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As a national church it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to bring the ordinances of religion to every parish in Scotland. It co-operates with other churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond. Religious observance is normally held every week in all churches, with occasional joint services.

Achievements and Performance

Canisbay Church Hall is normally well used by the local Mother and Toddler Group, Guild, Church Meetings and Social Events. A Prayer group is held on a Wednesday afternoon.

Financial Review

The principal source of income is through weekly offerings, with some standing orders. Gift Aid is claimed as appropriate. The balance at 31/12/24 is £37334

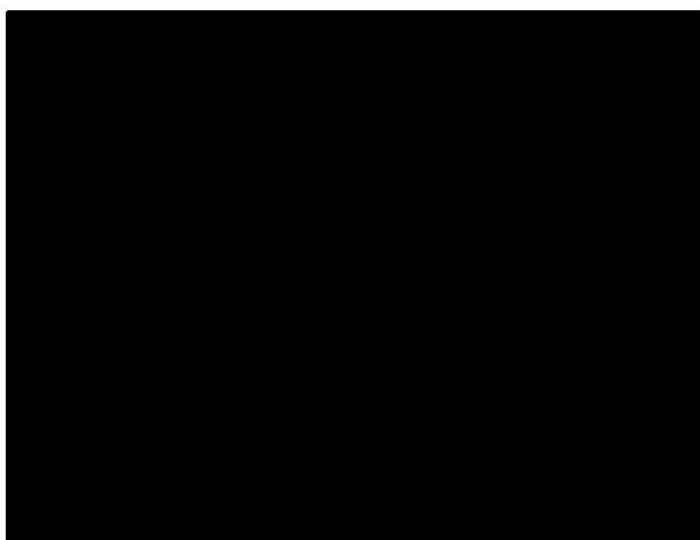
Reserves Policy

At the year end the Church held a total balance of £56318 not including money held by the General Trustees on behalf of Pentland Parish. The total expenses of the Church in 2024 amounted to £45235, and the total income for 2024 was £55198. This leaves an increase of £9962.

Statement of Trustees` Responsibilities

Members of the Kirk Session must prepare financial statements which give sufficient detail to enable an appreciation of the transactions of the church during the financial year. Those members are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which, on request, must reflect the financial position of the church at that time. This must be done to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005, the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2010, and the Regulations anent Congregational Finance approved by the General Assembly of The Church of Scotland in 2007. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the church and must take reasonable steps for the prevention and/or detection of fraud and other irregularities.
