What the charity does: Seamab is a charity based in Perth and Kinross that provides residential care and education for children and young people from across Scotland who have a variety of complex and additional support needs. We provide a variety of intensive and specialised wrap around supports with a particular focus on inspiring the young people to experience adventures in learning and life during their time with us. Children can come to us from the age of 5 up to the age of 18 and we are registered to provide both primary and secondary education. We have a Therapy Team to support our work in care and education, including an educational psychologist, play therapist and speech and language therapist.

(b) to provide those services to children in need due to disadvantage or other reasons. (c) to promote support for families of children in need by providing services for them.
