## INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT

To the Trustees of the Rotary Club of Prestwick Charitable Trust

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 30 June 2025, which are set out in the attached Trustees' Annual Report and Accounts.

### Respective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner
