Structure Governance & Management

Constitution

The charity was set up by John Wallace through a Deed of Endowment dated 30th April 1723.

Appointment of Trustees

Trustees consist of the Education Committee of Dumfries & Galloway Council who serve a term that coincides with the life of the elected council of Dumfries & Galloway.

Management

The monies were left in trust to be administered by the local council and following reorganisation representatives of Dumfries & Galloway Council deal with the day to day management of the Trust.

Objectives & Activities

Charitable purposes

The purpose of the trust is the advancement of education.

Activities

Grants are paid to schools and scholars in the electoral wards of Kirkland, Kello, Crichton, Douglas, Morton and that part of Dalswinton lying outside the parish of Dumfries, all in the government area of Nithsdale as established by the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 (a) and any subsequent extension of the wards.

Achievements & Performance

During the year grants amounting to £5,494 were paid out in accordance with the Deed of Endowment's objectives.

Financial Review

The trust is dependent on investment income and distributes this in full as grants in accordance with the Deed of Endowment.

The trustees therefore do not consider it appropriate to set a reserves policy.

Plans for Future Periods

The Trust has operated in accordance with the Trust deed and there are no plans to change its operation.
