Developing new skills, gaining experience, and boosting confidence.

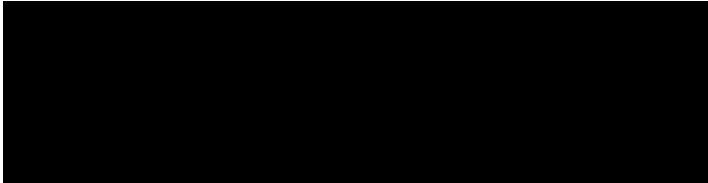

Financial Review: -

The trustees raised a total of £28,121 in the year (2023: £16,865).  
£17,855 from various donations and £10,266 from activities generating funds.  
Payments in the year totalled £21,504 (2023: £22566) towards fundraising trading costs  
and charitable activities.

Our reserves (funds which are freely available to meet the running costs of the group)  
net movement in funds of £6,617. The trustees have met this target at 31 July 2024.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of

Year Ended 31 July 2025

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 July 2025 which are set out on pages 6 and 8.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner: -

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)(d) of the 2006 Accounts Regulations does not apply. Basis of independent examiner's statement: -

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the 2006 Accounts Regulations. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.


Independent examiner's statement: -

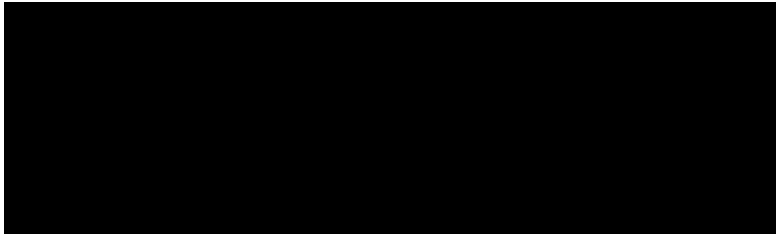
