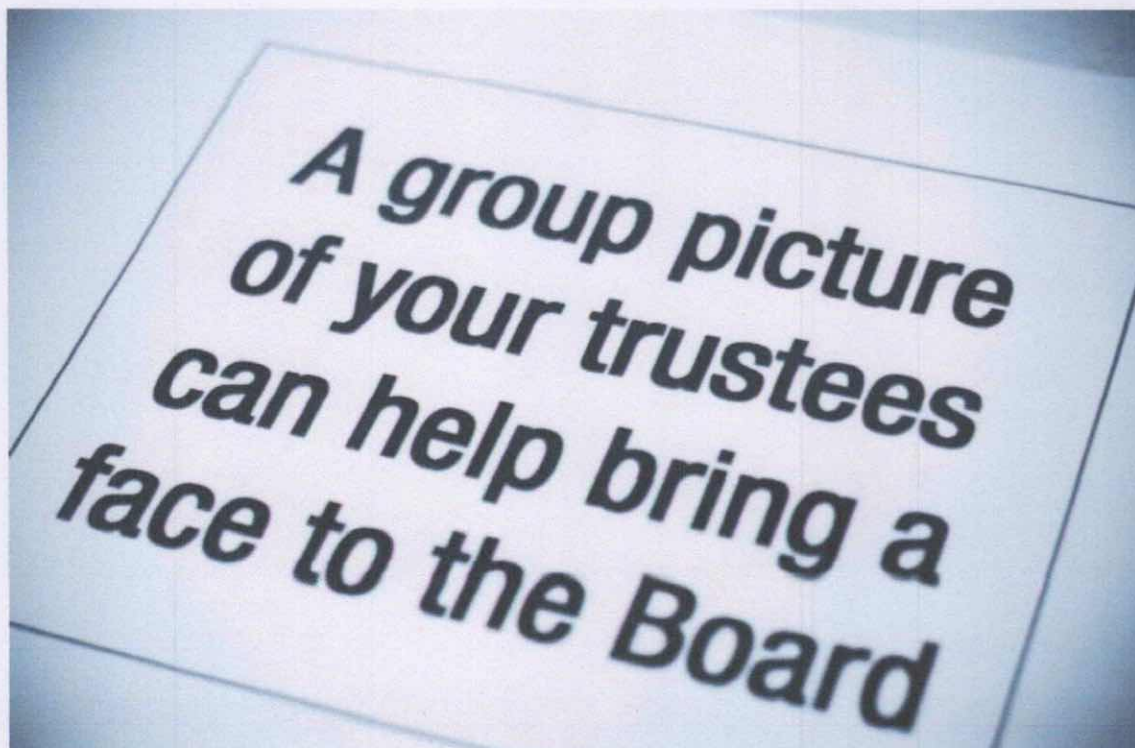

Objectives and activities

To raise funds to purchase extra goods and equipment that would benefit all the pupils at the local High School. The Committee normally meet about 3 times a year. The Trustees are responsible for the Strategic direction and governance of the group. The main source of funds were raised through a Winter disco, provision of food and drink at evening events. The club lottery was able to keep going as people paid monthly, draws were done monthly and prizes posted out by cheque. Profits spent on fundraising go to whatever Staff/pupils have requested and Committee selects by vote.

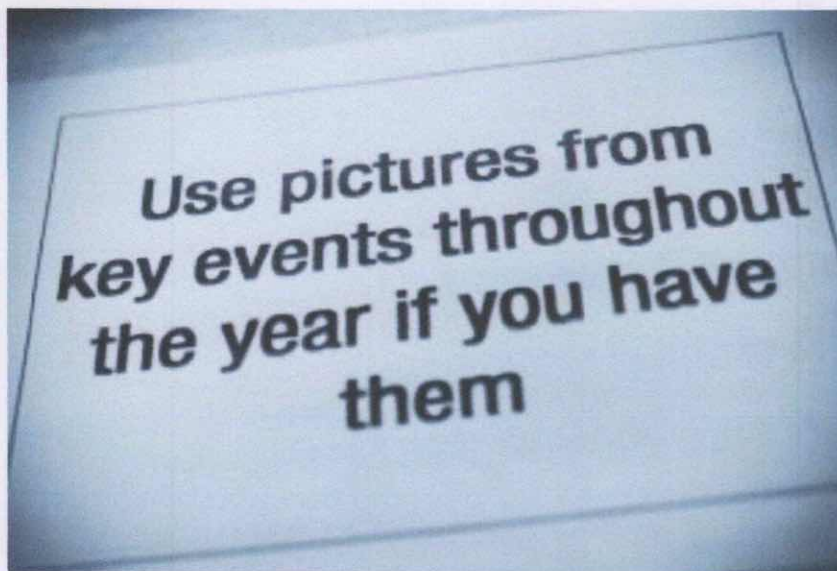
The Charity is an incorporated association. It is governed by it's constitution and has charitable status through OSCR.
