No application for grants was received in the period and no grants were made

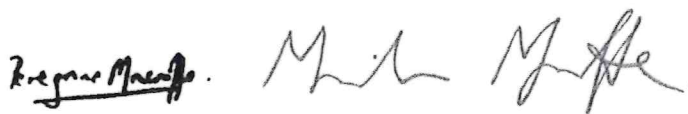
