Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

We provide a weekly food pantry, Breakfast Club and Cafe to tackle food and fuel poverty plus cooking classes. We provide holiday activities for Families, Bingo for older people, Mental Health support in addition to various classes supporting people looking to develop workplace skills.
