To whom it may concern,

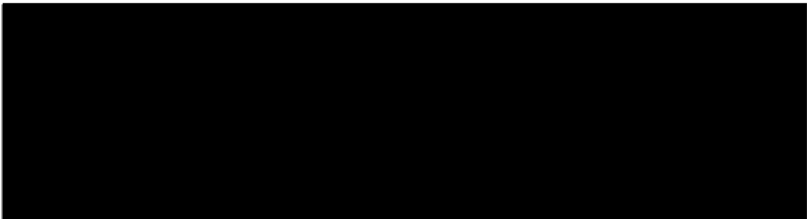
Following on from what I described last year, as a year of consolidation the best description for the 2024-25 year is one of rebuilding. Several changes to the committee took place at the AGM created a combined desire and will to expand the use and income. This was particularly relevant after the local authority announced the cessation of grant funding to community operated halls.

We continue to have the support of the main user groups plus a regular yoga class on a Wednesday evening. At the AGM we announced the creation of a committee post of hall promoter and this place was filled very quickly. Their role will be to promote the hire of the hall for private functions as well as organising fund raising functions.

Just before the AGM we were notified of our successful application to the regional lottery fund and received a grant to upgrade the heating and hot water systems. We will also install internet enabled controls for both. The work commences 21st July.

So, in summary the "Hall" is in good health. We continue on the "journey" and are most appreciative of the community support we receive.

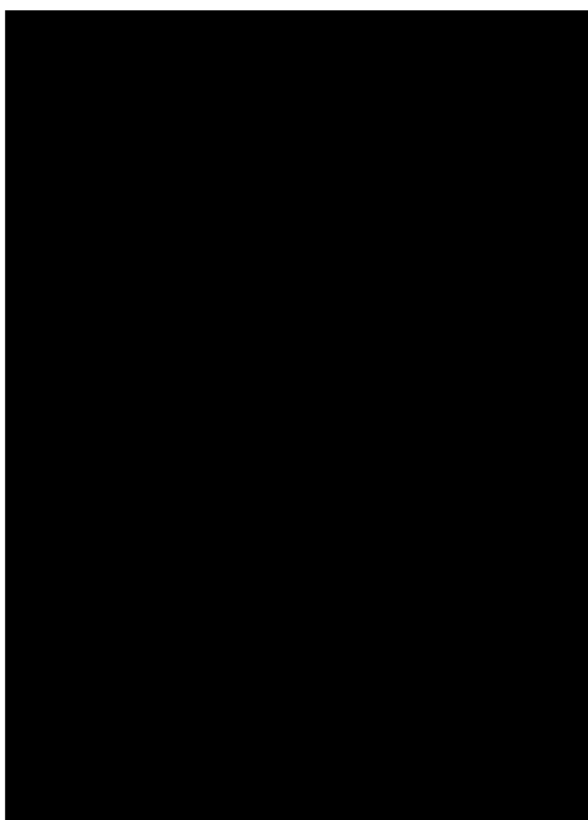
