What the charity does: The purposes of the Trust, is to use the capital and income of the fund for the prevention of relief of poverty, or relief of anyone in need by reason of age, ill health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage in respect of any persons resident in the Parishes of Torosay, Kinlochspelve, Salen or Ulva in the Isle of Mull.

Beneficiaries: 'Children or young people','Older People','Other charities or voluntary bodies'

Objectives: The charity trustees will have power to use both the capital and income of the trust fund to make grants for the prevention of relief of poverty, or for the relief of anyone in need by reason of age, ill health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage (a) any person on persons resident in, or (b) a project or scheme operating to benefit the residents of the Parishes of Torosay and Kinlochspelve and Salen and Ulva, all in the Isle Of Mull, Scotland. In the event of there being no beneficiaries or projects or schemes being identified within the said Parishes the trustees will have power to give grants to benefit residents elsewhere within the Church of Scotland Charge of 'The Isle of Mull Churches'.

Independent Examiner's Report

I report to the trustees on my examination of the financial statements of Mrs Elizabeth Henrietta Macquarrie Trust ('the charity') for the year ended 5 April 2026.

Respective responsibilities of Trustees

The charity's Trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination was carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Account (Scotland) Regulations 2006.
