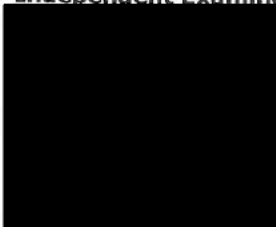

Report of the Trustees

The Trustees are pleased to present their report together with the financial statements of the church for the year ended 31 December 2024.

Status of Charity and Governing Document

North Tolsta is a congregation of the Free Presbyterian Church of Scotland ('the Church'). The organisation and government of the Church are based on the Presbyterian system. The constitution of the Church is identified in the deed of separation dated 14 August 1893.

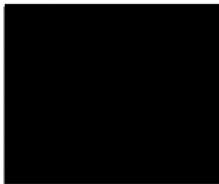
Aims and Affiliation

The congregation provides gospel ordinances and pastoral care in the area of North Tolsta. Any member of the public is welcome to attend the gospel services which are maintained in the Church building throughout the year.

Trustees and Office Bearers

The church is Presbyterian in government and its day to day running is undertaken by the Deacons (the Deacons' Court). The Deacons' Court is responsible for administering the temporal affairs of the Congregation, including the maintenance of the Church finances. All members of the Deacons' Court, except for the Chairman, are Trustees ex-officio.

Report of the Trustees

Appointment of Trustees

The Deacons' Court exercises its discretion in determining the most appropriate method of electing new Deacons (Trustees). Any election process must involve the communicant membership of the congregation. There is no fixed term for Trusteeship. Prior to their appointment, new Trustees would have served the church for some time in various roles and would be familiar with the church's values, its aims and objectives as well as its day-to-day operations. As part of their induction programme, new Trustees are required to understand their statutory responsibilities as well as their responsibility as Deacons.

Achievements and Performance

During the year, the church met regularly for worship and carried out various activities in pursuit of the above stated aims.

Financial review

Principal sources of funding

The church receives its funding from church members and adherents by way of weekly offerings and Gift Aid donations.

Reserves of the Congregation

General Fund

The Church Door Collection, taken by plate at each service, and other donations to Congregational Funds are recorded in the General Fund of the Congregation. The Church Door collection is the main source of income to the local congregation and is used to fund general congregational expenditure, including expenditure on the running and on-going maintenance of the church building and manse. In the year ended 31 December 2024 the General Fund shows a surplus of £888 (2023 - Surplus £23,792). This has led to the General Fund at 31 December 2023 increasing to £180,664 (2023 - £179,776)

Special Collections Fund

Collections and Donations received for specified central funds of the Church are recognised in the Special Collections Fund. The total amount of these collections and donations are remitted to the General Treasurer of the Church. In 2024, the total amount received for special collections was £16,672 (2023 - £19,056). Specific donations of £859 for the work of the Trinitarian Bible Society and £750 for Rev J Talloch were also received and disbursed.

The Deacons' Court are thankful that the funds of the Congregation continue to be in a healthy condition and they acknowledge their indebtedness to the great Head of the Church for His maintenance for His cause among us throughout another year and for giving our people a mind to do what they can in providing for its material needs. However, as always, we should be conscious that these are only a means to an end of advancing the Kingdom of Christ and seeking the good of souls in this world, for which the blessing of the Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary.

Report of the Independent Examiner to the Trustees *for the year ended 31 December 2024*

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2024 which are set out on pages 5 to 10.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement

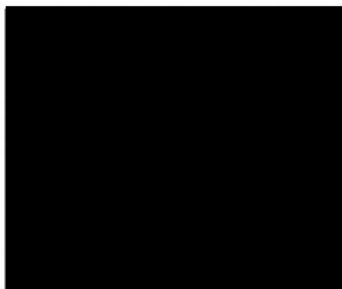
In the course of my examination, no matter has come to my attention:





1. Accounting Policies

Accounting Convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and under the guidelines laid down in the Statement of Recommended Practice - Accounting and Reporting by Charities (revised 2006)

Basis of financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared on a receipts and payments basis

Church Income

All voluntary income and bank interest is accounted for when received.

Fixed Assets

The congregation owns the Church and Manse. The Trustees do not have cost information available and they do not consider it an appropriate use of congregational funds to have properties valued purely for accounting purposes.

Statement of Balances

For the purpose of the statement of Balance as shown on page 6, funds are defined as follows:

Unrestricted funds comprise grants and other income received for the objects of the church without further specified purpose and are available as general funds.

Restricted funds comprise income which has been received for the objects of the church and specified for a restricted purpose within these objects by the donor.
