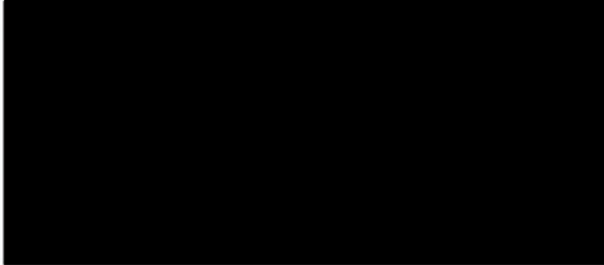

Structure Governance and Management

The Church is administered in accordance with the terms of the Deed of Constitution, which in the case of Methlick Parish Church of Scotland operates under the Unitary Constitution.

Recruitment and appointment of Trustees

Members of the Kirk Session are the charity Trustees and are the Elders of the Church chosen from those members of the Church who are considered to have the appropriate skills and gifts. The Minister, who is a member of the Kirk Session, is elected by the congregation and inducted by Presbytery.

Trustee Remuneration and expenses

The Minister received reimbursement of expenses during the year of £1,369 (2023: £2,752) incurred carrying out visits and other Parish work. No other Trustee received remuneration or expenses during the year.

Organisational Structure

The Kirk Session meets six times per year and is responsible for all affairs of the Church including Spiritual.

Objectives and Achievements

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine, reformed in tradition and Presbyterian in policy. It exists to glorify God and to work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As the national Church, it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to ring ordinances of religion to the people in every parish of Scotland through territorial ministry. It co-ordinates with other Churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond.

Methlick Parish Church of Scotland holds a Service of Worship each Sunday and two services for the main six monthly Communion Service. The Kirk has an active Guild, Prayer Group, Godly Play (Sunday School) Youth Group and Bible Study Group.

In addition a number of community activities were held during the year, including a Harvest Fair and several second hand sales events.

Financial Review

The Church has recorded an decrease in giving from Open Plate, weekly freewill envelopes, half yearly envelopes and monthly standing order of £2,369 from the amounts received in 2023.

The Church received no legacies in 2024 (2023: £4000)

The Church has continued its fund raising efforts, generating £5,024 in 2024 (2023: £2,270).

Due in large part to the Manse being rented out for most of 2024, an overall surplus of £23,956 was recorded for the year. (2023: Surplus £12,984) helping us to recover from the difficult past years.

The aim of the Trustees has always been to match the regular income of the Church with it's regular expenditure and based on up to date estimates the Trustees are aware this will become a harder aim to achieve.

The loss of the Manse rental income and a £19,190 rise in Giving to Grow Contribution in 2025 will completely eliminate the 2024 surplus.

The Church has tried to encourage people to increase their regular financial contributions to the Church in past years and also to give according to their time and skills in accordance with the Growing by Giving programme, however with the current difficulties faced by everyone in society we do not feel it is appropriate to push too hard with respect to financial giving, particularly since we have received so many generous one-off donations in the past years.

The Church fully expects to continue to meet all its financial commitments in the coming year, but may require to deplete reserves in order to achieve that goal. In the coming years the Church may require to deplete reserves further if it is not possible to match regular income with regular expenditure.

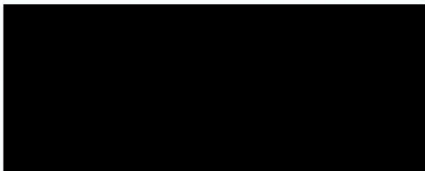
Reserves Policy

The Trustee's policy is to aim to hold reserves of approximately six months expenditure including designated funds. These reserves are to meet any unforeseen expenditure for property repairs and maintenance. At the year end the Church held unrestricted funds of £136,475 (2023: £108,734).

Statement of Trustee's Responsibilities

The members of the Kirk Session must prepare financial statements which give sufficient detail to enable an appreciation of the transactions of the Church during the financial year. The members of the Kirk Session are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which, on request, must reflect the financial position of the Church at any time. This must be done to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005, the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 and the Regulations Anent Congregational Finance approved by the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland in 2007. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Church and must take reasonable steps for the prevention and/or detection of fraud and other irregularities.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Methlick Parish Church of Scotland

I report on the accounts of the Charity for the year ended December 31, 2024 which are set out on pages 1 to 5.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement
