Structure, governance and management

The charity was founded in 1883. It has been a registered charity since 1906. The charity is constituted by a declaration of the Committee Members (who are deemed to be Trustees) and adopted by them on 1 April 2001.

The management committee shall consist of a maximum of nine trustees of whom one third shall retire annually, though they will be eligible for re-election. The management committee shall have the power to appoint sub-committees. The management committee shall elect a Chairperson, an Honorary Secretary and an Honorary Treasurer annually and appoint an external examiner of the accounts and such other officials as may be deemed necessary.

Trustees shall be recruited and appointed by the management committee.

Objectives and activities

The objective of the Trust is broadly to assist children in need in The Lothians in any manner the Committee Members deem appropriate.

They make bequests to charitable organisations in Lothian and to requests from individuals via professionals in: healthcare; education; and social services, where the emphasis is on assisting disadvantaged children.

Achievements and performance

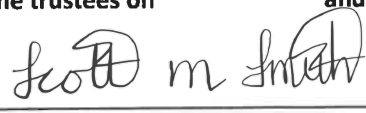
In the year to 30 September 2025 the charity dispensed £4,646 in grants to aid children and organisations working with children in the Lothians

Financial review

The total value of the Trust's funds held at 30 September 2025 on investment and on deposit is £200,204 (2024 - £188,922) (Note 2). The investment income generated from these holdings is fully utilised by the committee members in fulfilment of the charity's objectives and the financial position of the Trust on 30 September 2025 is disclosed in the accompanying accounts.

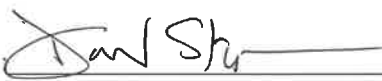
Basis of the Independent Examiner's Statement

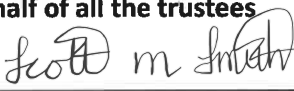
