These programmes include our monthly Faith Road Shows in Primary and Secondary Schools, our annual Uniting for Peace and Friendship programme, the annual Peace Walk to local places of worship, the Fringe Care Fest in local Care homes, and many other diverse and valuable programmes. All of this is achieved with own full time staff, one part time, and a loyal legion of dedicated volunteers
