I report on the accounts of the charity to the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025

**Respective responsibilities of trustee and examiner**


The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1)c of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

**Basis of independent examiner's statement**

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

**Independent examiner's statement**

In the course of my examination, no matter has come to my attention which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect the requirements to keep accounting records in accordance with Section 44(1) (a) of the 2005 Act and Regulation 4 of the 2006 Accounts Regulations, and to prepare accounts which accord with the accounting records and comply with Regulation 9 of the 2006 Accounts Regulations have not been met, or to which, in my opinion, attention should be drawn in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.

The Gift Shop is still extremely popular, staff, patients and visitors are incredibly supportive. We changed our opening hours slightly Monday to Friday 10.15am to 4.45pm. Collection box in shop takes in quite a bit of money.

### **What did we do with money we raised?**

The hospital is in the process of ordering a Proctomobile. The Proctomobile is used for the assessment of patients with Faecal Incontinence. It is a portable kit for basic anorectal manometry and endo-anal ultrasounds and will allow one-stop assessments for patients. It will prevent patients having to travel to Raigmore for assessment. Cost £38,000.

### **About ourselves**

We are a small group of volunteers who are very enthusiastic, we are always looking to recruit more volunteers to let extend our opening hours.

We are very grateful to bereaved families who have collections at funerals for us, also to grateful patients for their donations. Thanks to the ladies and volunteers who knit and crochet for us.

In closing once again I must thank the committee and our very loyal enthusiastic volunteers most sincerely for the support and help they have given during the year.

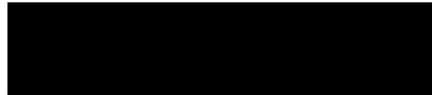
