Objectives: 1 The company's objects are:- 1.1 To promote civic responsibility, volunteering, the voluntary sector or the effectiveness or efficiency of charities principally in Renfrewshire and neighbouring local authorities ("the Operating Area"). 1.2 To relieve poverty primarily among the residents of the Operating Area. 1.3 To advance education primarily among the residents of the Operating Area, particularly among young

people and the unemployed. 1.4 To promote training in skills of all kinds, particularly such skills as will assist primarily residents of the Operating Area in obtaining paid employment. 1.5 To advance community development and regeneration primarily within the Operating Area and particularly (but without limitation) through: 1.5.1 assisting in the planning of changes to the housing and physical environment as part of a wider strategy for relief of the problems of poverty within the Operating Area. 1.5.2 the promotion of trade and industry, for the benefit of the general public. 1.6 To advance health (including the provision of health education) and to assist in the relief of ill health primarily among the residents of the Operating Area. 1.7 To promote, operate, establish and/or support other similar projects, programmes and/or schemes which further charitable purposes, particularly for the benefit of residents of the Operating Area, and to do so in a manner which is in line with the aims of Renfrewshire Community Planning Partnership
