Activities and Achievements

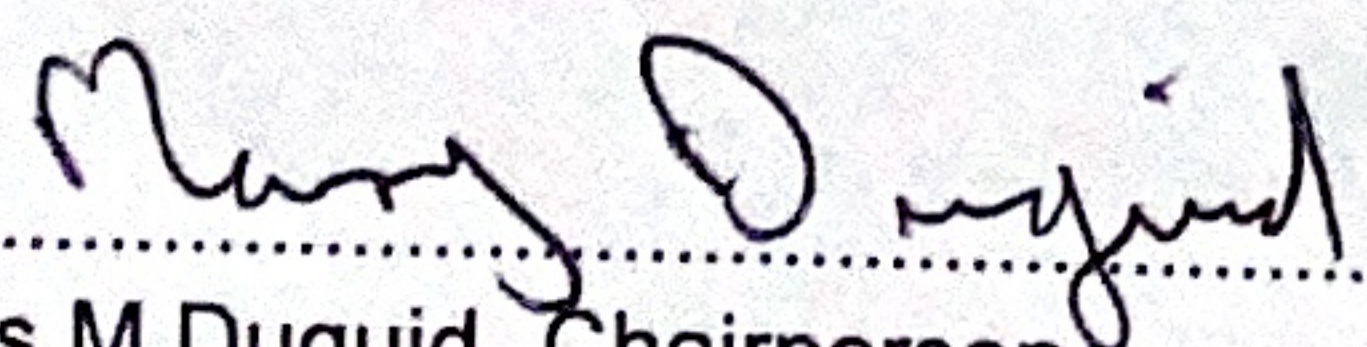

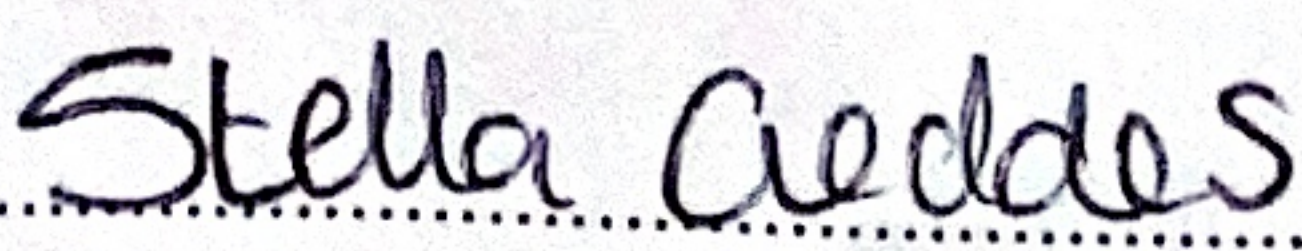

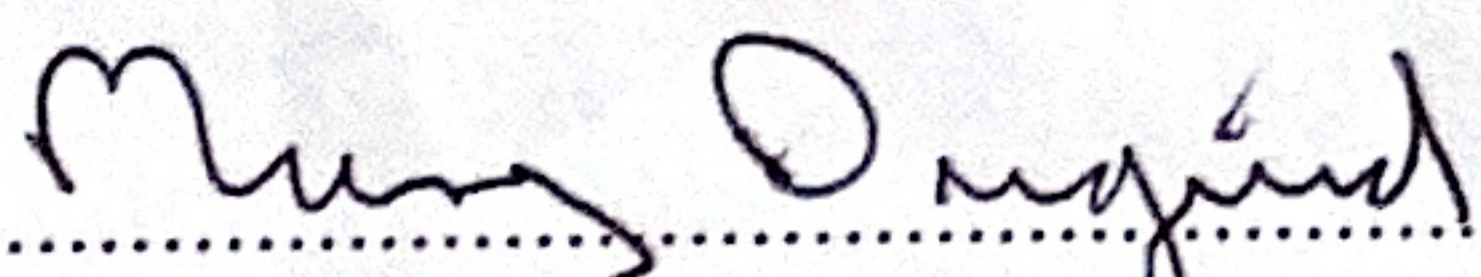

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Friends of Turriff Community Hospital

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year period 31 January 2026 which are set out on pages 2 to 4.

Respective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended). Basis of independent examiner's statement
