Entertainment is provided along with providing comforts at Christmas and Easter with the provision of cakes and gifts. Other treats/comforts provided include daily newspapers and chip shop meals for the patients.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of the League of Friends of Turner Memorial Hospital - Charity SC020128

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 30 September 2025.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended). The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the 2006 Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the 2006 Accounts Regulations. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Patients of Turner Memorial Hospital benefitted from the following achievements during the financial period:

- Chip Shop Suppers – supplied for patients. Initially one per week was provided then this was changed to monthly at the request of the hospital.
- Easter Party – patients enjoyed an Easter cake and Easter eggs.
- Christmas Presents and Christmas Cake – patients enjoyed a Christmas cake and Christmas presents.
- Laundry Services – the charity covered the cost of laundering clothes/pyjamas etc for patients that do not have access to having their clothes/pyjamas laundered.
- Entertainment – patients enjoyed a variety of entertainment such as Scottish music, ukulele group, monthly bingo sessions (with prizes) and therapy ponies for petting.
- Newspaper Subscription – patients have access to newspapers.
- 6 Specialist Mattresses paid for.
- Specialist Chair purchased for the Day Case Room.
- Wheelchair repair paid for.
- Stock of Toiletries – purchased for hospital to distribute to patients that don't have.

Income comes from fundraising, donations and bank interest. The main fundraising activity is the annual Coffee Morning.
