What the charity does: Our Chinese Christian Church exists to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with non-believers, especially within the Chinese community in the Aberdeen area, and to build up believers in their faith. This is achieved through weekly Sunday worship services, regular Bible study groups, monthly prayer meetings, annual summer outings for fellowship and outreach, and Chinese festival Gospel events that engage the wider community in culturally meaningful ways.

Beneficiaries: 'People with a particular ethnic or racial origin'

Objectives: To present Christ in accordance with the ACCF's doctrinal basis to all unbelievers, but in particular to the Chinese community in Aberdeen, and to build up believers in Christ.

Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

The church is an unincorporated association
It is governed by a Board of Deacons, consisting of a chairman, secretary, treasurer and at least two more members (see Article 7.1 of the Constitution of the church).

Trustee recruitment and appointment

Deacons must be baptised members of the church with fine Christian characters.
Candidates are recruited through a nomination committee which determines the suitability of individual nominees. The names of short-listed candidates are announced in the church at least 7 days prior to the AGM where the election and appointment of Deacons takes place (summarising from Article 7.2).

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

Based on the Doctrinal Basis of the church, we seek to share Christ with all non-believers, especially the Chinese in the Aberdeen area, and seek to build up the saints in Christ.

The objectives of the church are:

1. To preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ in and around the Aberdeen area, with a primary focus on the ethnic Chinese.
2. To build up the life of the Church through pastoral care, so as to meet the spiritual needs of different believers. This includes, but is not limited to, worship, fellowship, training and social service.
3. To cooperate with other churches or organisations which have compatible aims and beliefs.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

In achieving the said purposes above, the following weekly meetings are held:

Sunday Worship(Cantonese/Mandarin) - Sunday 1:45- 3:30pm

Prayer Meeting (once a month) - Sunday 3:30 – 4:00pm

Children's Sunday School - Sunday 2:15pm

Mandarin Fellowship (twice a month) – Tuesday 10:30-12:00pm

Cantonese Fellowship (twice a month) - Wednesday 10:30- 12:00pm

Pilgrims' Bible Study Group (twice a month) – Wednesday 10:30-12:00

Working Group Bible Study Fellowship (twice a month) - Friday 7:00 – 9:00pm

Running for Jesus (twice a month) – Saturday 10:30- 11:30am

Occasional events include evangelistic meetings and outreach to proclaim the good news, family and hospital visitations to share the love of God in a practical

Other optional information

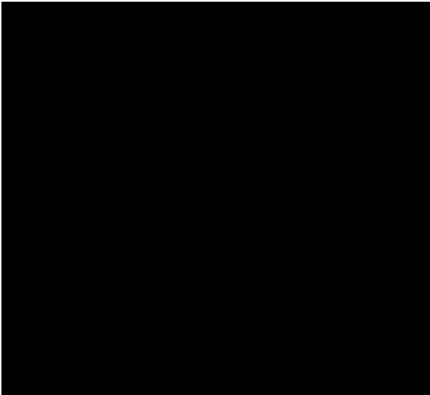
