What the charity does: The Holy Cross After School Club is set up to provide supervised play for school children for a an hours before school and/or few hours after school day in order to enable parents to work, study or pursue other activities. Every child at Holy Cross School is eligible to use the service regardless of religion, race or sex. In the event that places are limited, then selection criteria will be applied, taking parents circumstances into account. The club also offer holiday club during certain school holidays if there is demand. The service is provided at the Holy Cross Primary School grounds.

Beneficiaries: 'Children or young people'

Objectives: The aims of the After School Club shall be to provide supervised play for school children for a few hours after the school day, in order to enable parents to work, study or pursue other activities. Every child at Holy Cross School shall be eligible to use the service regardless of religion, race or sex. In the event that places are limited, then selection criteria will be applied, taking parents circumstances into account.

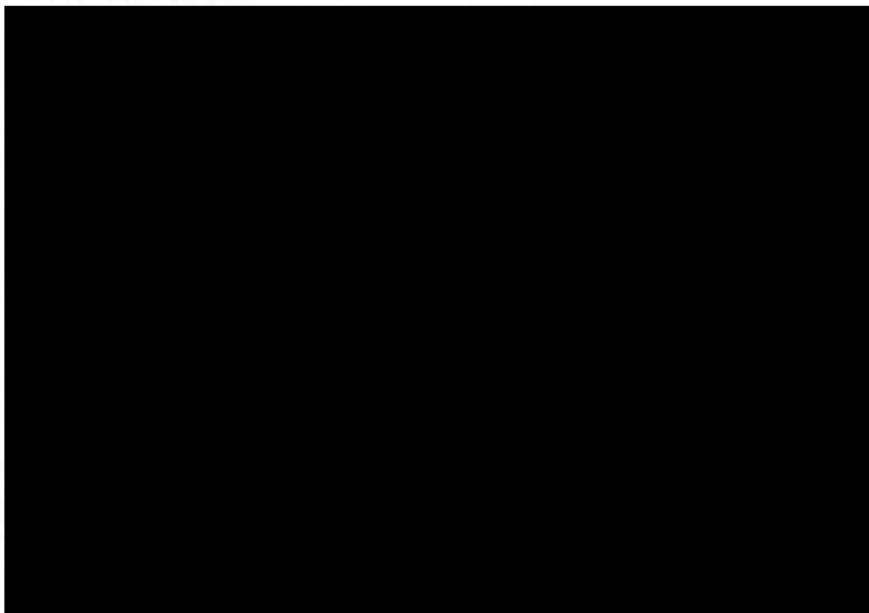

In the year we continued to operate the term time before and after school clubs in Holy Cross School. The holiday play scheme was successfully run during Easter 24, Summer 2024 and February 2025.

We are grateful to the local authority for their continuing support in providing free use of parts of Holy Cross Primary School for our activities and to the Head Teacher and staff of the school for their continuing assistance and support.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees Holy Cross After School Club

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2025 which are set out on pages 3 to 4.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement

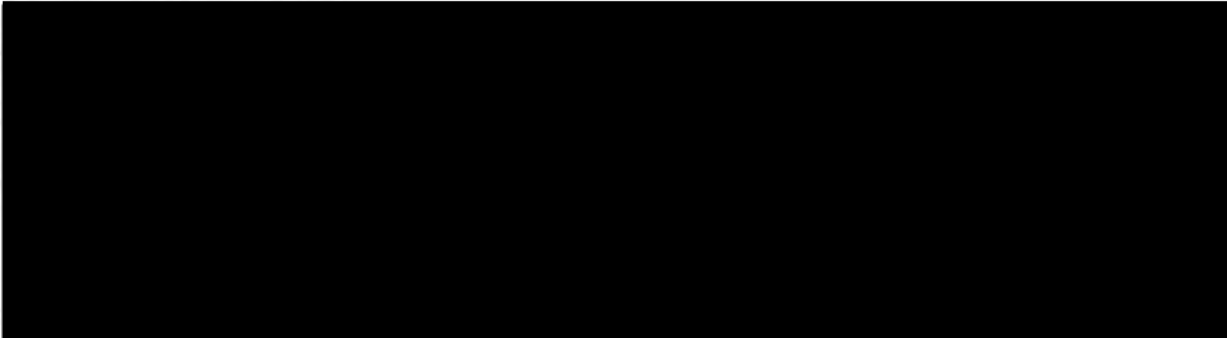
In the course of my examination, no matter has come to my attention

Trustee remuneration and expenses

The trustees did not receive any remuneration or expenses during the year.

Reserves

The club had a deficit of £17,605 for the year, the association held unrestricted funds of £29,741 at the year end.

The Committee consider the general fund of £29,741 will enable us to continue to run the after-school club and play schemes for the forthcoming year. There is recognition, however, that significant actions are needed to ensure the club doesn't rely so heavily on bank funding as in the past. Several actions have already been undertaken, such as increasing the fee which was set too low compared to other local clubs. It is also planned to expand the intake to include children from other nearby primary schools to ensure full capacity at the club. The financial performance of the before school club needs to be reviewed.
