The charity at present runs General Programme branch and centre classes, Saturday half day courses, Foundation Programme continue, also external business classes. Where we are now holding meditation classes, pujas, day courses and retreats. Over the coming months we will be look-ing to increase our branch meditation classes, throughout Dumfries & Galloway.
