Activities

Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the advancement of education', 'the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science'

What the charity does: Dollar Museum Trust was set up for the education of the general public by providing a physical museum for the storage, care, protection, display and interpretation of a collection of artefacts and archives relating to Dollar and its environs. The Museum has a range of permanent and temporary exhibitions and a reading/research room and is open every weekend between Easter and Christmas and at other times for special pre-booked visits. Educational visits are encouraged and received from local schools and other community groups, as well as individual researchers and pupils gaining project experience for the Duke of Edinburgh Award. The Museum website is updated regularly and gives much information for 'virtual' visitors. New exhibitions and developments are researched and undertaken by Trustees and volunteers from the Friends of Dollar Museum, who also arrange a variety of activities to raise funds for the maintenance of the Museum and to safeguard its future development.

Beneficiaries: 'No specific group, or for the benefit of the community'

Objectives: The Trustees shall hold the Trust Fund and the Existing Collection In Trust (a) for the advancement of the education of the general public, without distinction of sex or of political, religious or other opinions, by provision of the Museum comprising the Existing Collection together with such other objects, specimens or collections as may from time to time be acquired in accordance with the provisions of the Deed ('the Collection'), in respect of which there will be a strong presumption against the subsequent disposal of any specimen. (b) to provide for the protection of the specimens comprised in the Collection from

deterioration, damage, loss, accidental destruction or unauthorised disposal. (c) to form, establish and support and to aid in the formation, establishment and support of any other charitable companies, institutions, associations, trusts or societies formed for objects similar to the objects set out above.
