(c) (i) The deity of the only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, the Word made flesh. (ii) Christ's virgin birth. (iii) Christ's blameless life. (iv) Christ's atoning death on Calvary's Cross. (v) Christ's glorious resurrection on the third day. (vi) Christ's ascent to the Father's right hand. (vii) the reality of Christ's promise to come again for those who love him. and (viii) that in Christ, through faith, we can know our sin is

forgiven and be assured of eternal salvation.
