The Trustees shall have power to apply the Trust Fund in the attainment of the purposes of the Trust and that to such an extent as they may from time to time think fit and, in so far as any such income is not so utilised in any one year it shall be retained by the Trustees and used in the following year or years for the purposes of the Trust.
