Activities

Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the prevention or relief of poverty'

What the charity does: The Trust has for 30 years provided a service recycling furniture and household items in order to supply them at low cost to those in need in the Helensburgh area of Argyll and Bute. Frequently the Trust responds to requests from social services organisations to help individuals in need who are moving into new housing. We are also able to sell fully tested electrical appliances and household goods at affordable prices to fund our day to day operations. The Trust is entirely staffed by volunteers and operates a shop to sell recycled items ranging from white goods to bedding and kitchen utensils. We also operate a van to pick up and deliver furniture and white goods.

Beneficiaries: 'No specific group, or for the benefit of the community'

Objectives: The purpose and objects of the Trust are to relieve poverty in Helensburgh and the surrounding areas and in furtherance thereof to distribute goods and funds to those persons demonstrably capable of showing a genuine need of the same and to do all things as will properly attain the above purpose and objects.
