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Activities

Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the advancement of education', 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science'

What the charity does: To establish and maintain a museum for the benefit of the public, to house protect, and maintain into the future such artifacts which make up the collection of aircraft, documents, books, photographs, uniforms, medals, instruments, and other material/artifacts as exist from the Royal Flying Corps and Royal Air Force squadrons stationed at Montrose between the periods 1913 to 1952, plus squadrons with a close association with Montrose as well as the RAF in Scotland since 1913 to the present day. The advancement of RAF heritage and history and the education of the general public through Montrose Air Station Museum without distinction of age, gender, disabilities and political, religious or other opinions.

Beneficiaries: 'Children or young people', 'Older People', 'People with disabilities or health problems', 'People with a particular ethnic or racial origin', 'Other defined groups', 'No specific group, or for the benefit of the community', 'Other charities or voluntary bodies'

Objectives: The Trustees shall hold the Trust Fund and the Existing Collection IN TRUST a) for the advancement of the education of the general public, without distinction of sex or political, religious or other opinions, by provision of the Montrose Air Station Heritage Centre comprising the Existing Collection together with such other objects, specimens or collections as may from time to time be acquired in accordance with the provisions of this Deed ('the Collection'), in respect of which there will be a strong presumption against subsequent disposal of any specimen. b) to provide for the protection of the specimens comprised in the

Collection from deterioration, damage, loss, accidental destruction or unauthorised disposal. c) to form, establish and support and to aid in the formation, establishment and support of any other charitable companies, institutions, associations, trusts or societies formed for objects similar to the objects set out above.
