Targets for 2024/2025

- £15,000 now up to £20,000 ringfenced for running expenses.
- £20,000 for replacement minibus.
- Four windows to be replaced in upstairs classrooms and redecorate.
- 2 sit on kayaks to be purchased @ £499 each.
- Equipment no longer in use – to be sold.
- Hydraulic steering on safety boat needs replacing - £1,000.
- Storage for Junior Cadet resources.
