### Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Nil. The charity is stagnant until it is either resurrected or formally dissolved with funds and other assets distributed by the trustees in accordance with Scottish charity law.

A few parents continued to donate for some months into the period until they responded to a further letter to stop. Funds currently stand at £2,822 with bank charges the only outgoings. This compares with £2,745 as at March 31 2025.


