Achievements and performance

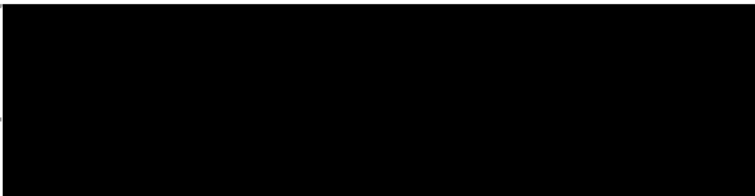
