**Activities:** 'It carries out activities or services itself'

**Purposes:** 'the advancement of education', 'the advancement of health', 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the advancement of public participation in sport', 'the provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended', 'the advancement of environmental protection or improvement', 'the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage', 'any other purpose that may reasonably be regarded as analogous to any of the preceding purposes'

**What the charity does:** The primary function of CYP is to help and support young people and it is very encouraging to report that year on year our young people continue to make real progress. The Youth Work Team are instrumental in creating vibrant Youth Clubs at both P6 and P7 with both operating at capacity, providing structured activities each week. Exciting Activity programmes are also provided during holiday periods and these are very popular. The team also work closely with staff at McLaren High School to provide support for up to 19 young people who have difficulty engaging with mainstream education. This can be both pastoral and practical, with the latter including volunteering in the garden and undertaking Catering for the Future training.
