## Independent Examiner's Report to the Members of the Society of the Innocents – Inverclyde Branch

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31st December 2025

### Respective responsibilities of committee and examiner

### Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement

The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently, I do not express an audit opinion on the review given by the accounts.
