What the charity does: The charity provides facilities , and a lunch club on tuesday's and saturday's for members of the community. All are welcome. The charity encourages members to use the garden facilities and get involved in growing and harvesting food, which is incorporated into the lunch club menu. Other events that the community can get involved in include: Qui Gong, Kumon classes, tango and flamenco dancing. The charity is currently running a recycling workshop program for younger people who can come and learn how to recycle and raise awareness. A local Indian dance class is also present, and continues to look for new members. Various cultural events occur during the year which are open to all members of the community

maintain and manage the same (whether alone or in co-operation with any local or other person or body) in furtherance of the above object (c) Promote such other charitable purposes as may from time to time be determined
