There is also an annual regatta which is held using our facilities. We maintain 4 moorings mainly used by visiting yachts but they can be used by anyone looking for sanctuary, to maintain this we ask for a mooring fee and are luck enough to have the support of a local business. The area is also used by people who have their own pleasure boats and is also used by local fishermen as well. We have two buildings which need to be maintained and this can only be achieved with donations and volunteers giving their time and expertise.
