(c) 'To advance parenting skills through the provision of support, training and advice to families and the public in

more effective ways to care for children, and in the importance of sound relationships between parents and children, for the maintenance and enrichment of family life. (d) 'To advance education among prisoners in relation to the development and welfare of children for the benefit of families directly affected by imprisonment and in order to increase awareness in prisoners of their role as parents/carers. (e) 'TO promote, establish and operate other schemes of a charitable nature.
