## Activities

**Activities:** 'It carries out activities or services itself'

**Purposes:** 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended', 'the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage'

**What the charity does:** Elgin Youth Development Group was established in 1998 in response to concerns that young people did not have a safe space to meet and socialise. Since then, we have developed as an organisation to include a thriving youth café, The Warehouse, a social enterprise, The Inkwell & a new training café which provides employability opportunities for young people. As an organisation, we now support young people from 11 to 24 through both our youth work provision & our employability services. While we are an inclusive organisation, we aim to work with young people who are considered the most vulnerable and those living in the most challenging circumstances.

**Beneficiaries:** 'Children or young people', 'People with disabilities or health problems'

**Objectives:** Charitable Purposes 54 The organisation's Charitable Purposes are 54.1 To provide a community hub and a wide range of projects and activities primarily for the benefit of people living within the Moray community. 54.2 To provide a safe and inclusive place where young people of secondary school age primarily living within the Elgin community council boundary are able to meet and socialise away from the pressures of drugs, alcohol and gambling, and to provide personal and social development opportunities for all young people of secondary school age. The Group will provide projects and activities that will positively influence young people from all social, ethnic, religious and cultural backgrounds to integrate, and become

valued and active members of their community. 55 The Company's Charitable Purposes are restricted to those set out in article 3 (but subject to article 5). The Company may add to (subject to first obtaining the consent of OSCR), remove or alter the statement of the Company's Charitable Purposes in article 4. On any occasion when it does so, it must give notice to the registrar of companies and the amendment will not be effective until that notice is registered on the register of companies.
