What the charity does: The Charity was set up to promote the playing of traditional Scottish music. It organises the annual Elgin Fiddle Festival to encourage young players to perform in public. It organises an annual Rally and invites players from all over the country to join members in a concert. It also encourages its members to participate in rallies held by similar organizations. It plays for various groups and organizations in and around Moray. Its members also participate in the Scotland-Scandinavia Traditional Music Association meetings.

Beneficiaries: 'Children or young people','Older People','People with disabilities or health problems','No specific group, or for the benefit of the community','Other charities or voluntary bodies'

Objectives: The Society has charitable status in Scotland and is established to promote and perform instrumental music, principally the music of Scotland, in order that: (a) the community's interest in such music shall be encouraged and advanced by public and private concerts given by the Society or under its auspices from time to time and also through broadcasting media and recordings and (b) traditional fiddle playing of such music shall likewise be preserved, encouraged and promoted within Scotland by such activities as rallies, workshops and festivals and, where finances permit, promoted abroad by cultural visits and exchanges abroad.

Trustees Report 2025

The Society carried out a range of activities in pursuit of its objectives.

The Elgin Fiddle Festival continues to encourage an interest in traditional Scottish fiddle music by giving people of all ages a chance to perform in public, obtain useful feedback on their progress and hear some of the country's top performers. Ages range from under nine, 10-12 years, 13-16 years, senior and championship classes with both solo and group competitions.

The Annual Rally brings fiddle and accordion players together from all around the country and helps to strengthen the purpose and co-operation of all like-minded fiddle societies. Elgin Town Hall was not available due to refurbishment, but the use of the Elgin Academy's premises turned out to be very successful, and we are very grateful to TSI Moray for giving us a grant to offset the higher costs involved and thus keep ticket prices stable.

Members of the Society continued to play an active part in the Scotland-Scandinavia Music Association, supported a number of fiddle rallies around Scotland and played at a variety of private and public functions in and around Moray during the year.

The Society continues to keep Scottish Fiddle Music in the public mind by going out to play for a variety of organizations whenever requested.




