Community, and in particular (but without limitation) through providing childcare facilities (for children of pre-school age and, in the form of out-of-school care, for children of school age) which enable the parents or guardians of such children who would otherwise have difficulty in meeting childcare costs to access and/or maintain themselves in paid employment. and (3) To advance education, in particular among pre-school children and (in the form of out-of-school educational activities) among children of school age. But only to the extent that the above purposes are consistent with furthering the achievement of sustainable development. For the purposes of paragraph 4(1)(b), an organisation shall only be treated as a social enterprise if (i) it has an asset lock, whether by way of provision in its constitution or by way of a statutory asset lock, and is non-profit distributing, or (ii) it is a wholly-owned subsidiary of a body which has such an asset lock.”
